place smells like smoke non-stop, and I have allergies because of it. I know it's him, because I know the people on the other sides of me, and one of them doesn't smoke, and the other person does it outside, and the smell from that goes away within minutes, because of the wind and air. But the person above me must smoke with no ventilation or anything, nonstop. All my clothes and everything in my unit smells of smoke. I light candles and have 2 air purifiers, but they don't even put a dent in it.

But the main thing is the person stomping and dropping stuff above me, every morning/night, at 3am, 4am, and 5am, on the dot. I have no idea what this person has against me. yeah.. I hear ya! I have a neighbor above me who harassed me every day for almost 3 years.

Each morning I get up, he starts rocking my apartment- similar to an earthquake. He will do that all day long. When I take a shower, he will repeatedly change the water temperature from hot to cold and back. No matter how dang tired I get later in the day, he will start making my floor vibrate. (I am a light sleeper) When I was down with the cold, he would not let me sleep. He goes off to the landlord, and whine like a snot-nosed 5 year old brat, and tell lies to her about me. I have not ever had any problem with this guy until back in 2009. It started with him slamming doors day and night.. it took me awhile to track it down to this guy. Many of my neighbors who knows him, for many years has told me to stay away from this guy. He even told me himself one day that he terrorized an elderly lady who used to live on his floor. And would steal from her..and I suspect he is doing the same thing to me.. I've had lots of stuff stolen from me. The landlord does not care.

When I first told the landlord and the resident coordinator that my apartment has been broken into, back in late 2009 they said I was lying! What in the freakin world does anyone would ever make that up?? That was the most insane, and very dangerous way to tell someone- who is physically disabled?? I am! I use a walker. I have Cerebral Palsy. I am also deaf- but I wear hearing aids, and can hear 80% out of both hearing aids.

I have talked to Legal aid, I spoke to the police, they tell me they cannot mess with

landlord/tenant problems. I had informal conferences. I've asked for a Reasonable of Accommodations to move to a different floor or even to a different building. I was denied 7 times in a row- even with doctor's notes. I even got my brother to install a door alarm, that didn't scare this guy off, I tried a webcam with a vcr recording, that didn't work either..

If I talked out loud, farted, laughed, or belched, he start raising the vibrations or the shakings. I have learned he might have a listening device in my apartment.. In fact, I found out that he has abused women in the past, and watches them.. so.. I figured that out already, because how would he know I had taken my hearing aids out? He likes to randomly drop heavy items, or slamming doors to startle me and get my goat. I've had several meltdowns- (Point where I had lost it and wouldn't be able to shut my mouth for a while) I even had to stay the night at my friend's apartment in order to get some sleep...

I love playing video games! I have a GameCube console- I bought myself. I have only one game I play on it. (I am not fond of action/adventure, combat, shooting, fighting games- I rather have nice cute, clean games to play) and each time I play it, he throws a fit. This game is run on real time, and I haven't played it since before Thanksgiving.

It greatly hit me hard when a few times I started praying out loud for this guy to chill out! And coming home from a Thanksgiving dinner with my friend last month (same friend who I stay the night, when this guy wouldn't shut up) to find parts of my bible book tabs has been ripped off and bent. To me, that is definitely a sign that this person must really hated me and had some serious issues with God...and to me, I do forgive

people, yes.. but this one is considered an Unforgiveable sin to me! Many of my friends has been on my side. Our Landlord does not know squat how to be a nice landlord!

I was surprised one day earlier this year that my landlord claimed I was the one who has been harassing this guy for a year?? After all the 1 and 1/2year's worth of documenting his daily tirades? My Landlord said she's known this guy only for a year (LOL!!!!) A year? My butt! Try at least 7+ years! And told me to bug off, am forbidden to be on his floor (I live in a high rise building of 12 floors- I am on the 3rd, his on 4th) and threatened to evict me! I shut my mouth up for 2 months.. and nothing worked. He continued to get around the lying, stealing, etc... But get this: During my informal meeting, my brother was with me along with the Landlord, her boss, their Real Estate Specialist, the mediator and the asst. manager. I had said to the group during the meeting, "I was told I've been harassing this guy for a year, then how come I wasn't notified?" Everyone had a very awkward silence. At that split moment, both my brother and I realized that my Landlord obviously knew something, and she was hiding the truth! And then I saw it! She is, and still has been actively involved in this illegal act of harassment...What in the world is this all about?

Each time he sees me, I'd feel doomed.. because every time he sees me around, he will get all worked up and cause a lot of noise. Even past curfew hours which is from 11pm-7am...

I am on a wait list to 3 other buildings.. and still haven't gotten to the top yet.. I still haven't found out why he wouldn't leave me alone?? I'd hope each day when I get up, I find out he'd die during the night, or
